Regulations of the event Hanukkah with little Majer - family finissage of a temporary exhibition (hereinafter: "Regulations")

- 1. The event is of an educational and artistic nature.
- The event takes place on December 15, 2024 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The event is organized by the POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews, ul. Anielewicza 6, 00-157 Warsaw, tel. 22 471 03 01, <u>www.polin.pl</u>; e-mail: <u>polin@polin.pl</u>
- 3. The condition for using the event is to read and comply with the Regulations below. Failure to comply with the Regulations below may result in calling the appropriate security services to remove the user of the event or taking other actions to stop violations of the Regulations.
- 4. Entering the area where the event takes place is tantamount to accepting the Regulations. Acceptance of the Regulations is necessary to use the event.
- 5. The event is open to the public and its use is free of charge. Minors may use the event only in the presence of an adult guardian, who is also responsible for damages and accidents caused by them and by minors under their care.
- 6. The event consists of the following activities (hereinafter: "events"): family game, entertainment at the "King Matt's" Family Education Area, guided walks through the temporary exhibition, Hanukkah photo booth, visiting the permanent or temporary exhibition with an audio guide.
- 7. It is prohibited for people under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or other substances with a similar effect to be present at the event. It is also prohibited to consume alcoholic beverages, take narcotics or other substances with a similar effect at the event.
- There is a total ban on smoking, bringing any dangerous materials or objects, in particular weapons, firecrackers, sparklers, flares, knives and using open fire at the event.

- 9. There is a total ban on littering and leaving leftovers of food or drink on the event grounds.
- 10. We inform you that during the event, photos will be taken and videos will be recorded, which will be published on the Museum's social media (including Facebook, Instagram), on the Museum's websites, for promotional purposes of the Museum and in connection with the implementation of statutory obligations, i.e. supporting and conducting artistic activities and promoting culture.
- 11. Any obscene behavior, using offensive vocabulary, proclaiming and displaying slogans with obscene, vulgar, racist or other content violating or potentially violating personal rights and generally applicable legal regulations, inciting conflict on national, religious or social grounds, as well as any behavior that violates social and moral norms is prohibited.
- 12. Damaging, destroying or stealing elements present on the event grounds is prohibited.
- 13. The Organizer's security services and the city security services have the right to remove from the event area people who violate the provisions of the Regulations or to take other appropriate actions aimed at stopping violations of the provisions of the Regulations.
- 14. The event area is constantly monitored. In the event of noticing a threat, people using the event should:
